During the last couple of weeks we have been talking and learning about:

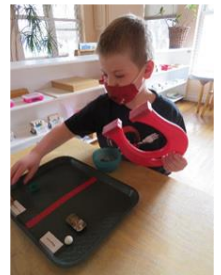
- Artic vs Antarctica animals
